In the meantime I (Chris Hughes) propose not to put in the invoice to the club for the website update to date (10 months fee) and wish you to accept this as a personal donation to the club from Victoria and myself.
4. A proposal has also been received asking that the club rules be changed to ALL seatbelts to be full harnesses on trials vehicles – standard seat belts / inertia seatbelts / lap belts etc. are NOT adequate in a full rollover, a backward or forward roll or if a vehicle ends up upside down and on fire (VERY difficult to release).

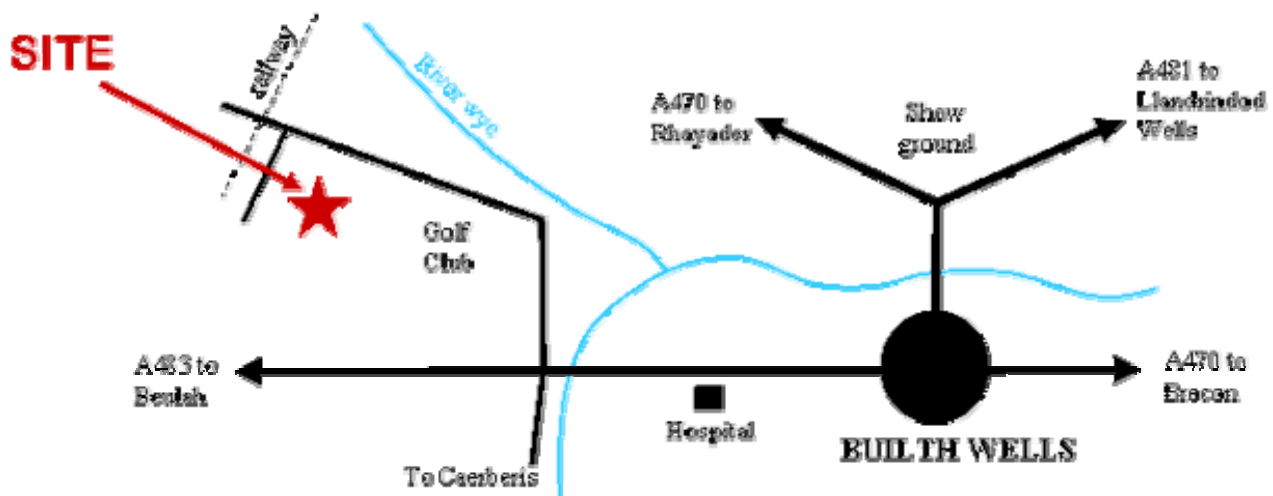
