Vehicle de-bogging - keeping control of towing / snatching

Roll-over recovery - safe methods

Winch recovery - the do's & don'ts

We will set up real scenarios for each item - this is not theoretical stuff, folks!!

The training sessions are **£10.00** per person (this will be donated to the Air Ambulance) and will be held near Newbridge on Wye with MWMAC Ltd. ("Land-based Training for Professionals")
