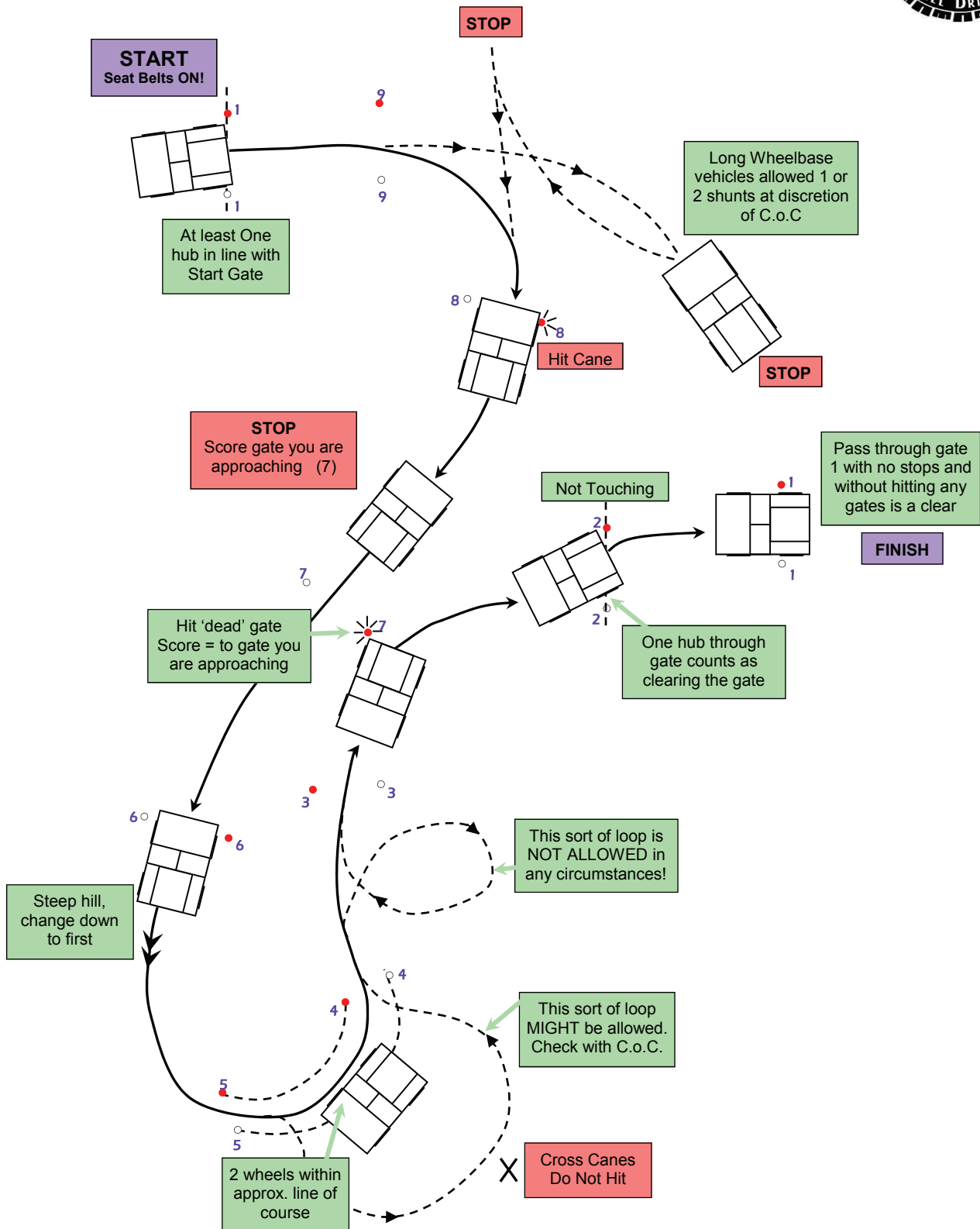


# Trials Rules Diagram

(This diagram is a visual explanation of the Clubs trialing rules, the full rules are explained within the Handbook)



Scoring any points normally requires you to stop and leave the section. For instance, on hitting the eight gate you would normally leave the section with a score of Eight. The CoC may allow you to continue for practice or to clear the section for the next driver but your score is unaffected.

The "one hub rule" applies when one front hub is past the line between both canes, you must remain stationary, if at all possible, until a Marshall or the CoC confirms that you have cleared that gate..

Touching cross canes ( boundary marker ) counts as hitting the gate you are **approaching**, in the diagram hitting the cross canes would score you **Four** points.
